This programme is part of our Winter Outreach and it is offered from November to April.

What did the environment around your school look like 12,000 years ago? Or 120 years ago? What are some of the animals and plants that grow and live along the waterside? Who were some interesting or famous people who used to live right next door? In this bespoke programme, our Education Officer comes to your school to help you find out more about your local environment. Activities: interactive timeline and guided walk along the river/canal and art workshop (for the full-day option).

On the Day

The class engages in a classroom activity where they explore objects to create a map or timeline to learn more about their local environment. They then go on a guided walk with activities to the river/Union Canal. For full-day programmes, the education officer leads a local environment-themed art workshop in the afternoon. This programme is only on offer to schools within walking distance of the river.

All adults and children should come dressed for the weather in comfortable outdoor clothing with sturdy footwear that they don't mind getting muddy.
